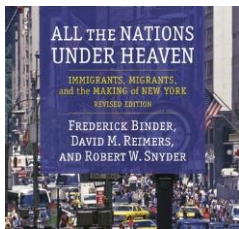

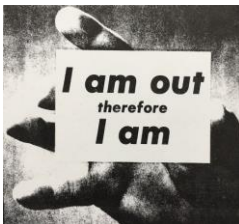
Immigrants, Migrants, and the Making of New York **Sunday, June 2nd, 2:00 - 3:15pm**
