



DOROT Jewish Summer Teen Internship Program in Riverdale

FAQs

What does a typical day look like?

This summer the DOROT Summer Teen Internship will operate virtually. All programming will take place via Zoom or other video chat platform or via telephone conference calls.

Interns volunteer in small groups and receive training, supervision and coaching in all their volunteer tasks. Interns experience weekly service-learning and group reflection meetings and join the Senior Center older adult participants for daily intergenerational activities via Zoom.

The internship begins with a virtual two-day orientation and training session.

What expenses are associated with the program?

There is no charge to intern with DOROT.

Is there anything I should know about the application process?

Each year, the process gets more competitive. DOROT chooses 16 interns for the program each summer. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis beginning in December 2021 and ending on June 1, 2022; we encourage students to apply early. All applicants are required to participate in a group interview.

Is there anything else I should know?

Students who are invited to participate as interns and accept the position receive online orientation and training, coaching and supervision along with program supplies. Interns must have access to a computer, smart phone or tablet with WIFI connectivity and video capability. DOROT staff is pleased to provide college recommendations for exemplary performance.
